


# Westminster Presbyterian Church The Chimes

Caregiving looks like strengthening our resolve to be people who give and receive love in community. This is called a *beloved community* or a *shalom community*. It looks like empowering people to **be** the church. Being a *beloved community* is where God's love and justice are experienced realities so that healing, enthusiasm, and growth can occur in each one of us. It looks like creating relational bridges that span people's multiple gaps of uncertainty. These gaps are found within us and can be put upon us by "outsiders" who are "different" from us. Individually, these gaps prevent us from being in a growing authentic relationship with God. Collectively, it inhibits us from being a *beloved community*.

Caregiving is spiritual. Being spiritual is a practice. Practicing our spirituality is what we have all learned to do, believe and ponder. We've learned to cope with these practices because we've learned there are things we can't control (newsflash J). Let's work on things we can control. Things like strengthening and blending our traditions with innovations, finding practical solutions to modern challenges, adapting church practices to meet contemporary needs, and striving to be approachable and relatable to our immediate and extended congregation and community. This places value on authenticity and transparency, which is an important attribute in healthy growing churches. It looks like defining our values and living into them. It looks like reframing our church's collective identity and shared norms so that we function as God's beloved caregiving community with love and hope. And remember, we're in this together.
